**Grace Christian School is invited to sell Community Day booklets in our stores!**

Selling booklets in our stores is a huge advantage for your organization.

- There are customers entering our stores on a consistent basis.
- The customers that enter already know us for great value and enjoy redeeming coupons.
- Everyone in your organization can participate in selling booklets.
- Each organization will be provided with a table and two chairs at a high traffic location within the store.

We ask that all organization members:

- Are age 16 or older, or accompanied by an adult
- Dress appropriately; no jeans, sweatpants or shorts
- Wear school/organization uniforms or t-shirts if available
- Wear comfortable shoes
- Always act professional and treat all customers in a friendly manner

Organization members are asked to report to their assigned stores at the beginning of their scheduled shifts. Allow enough time to hang your coat and if necessary check your handbag in with security. Each member of the organization will be expected to sign in with the store manager or Community Day Event Captain when they report for duty and sign out when they have completed their shift.

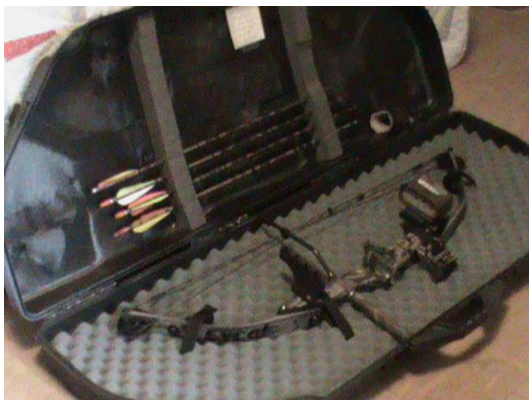
**Extra Incentives**

Sign up for at least one shift from now through November 13 and your group will be on its way to earning extra incentives. Organizations that complete the 3 steps below will qualify to earn an equal amount from the in store booklet sales.

1. Sell a minimum number of booklets (ask your Community Day Captain).
2. Sell in store at least one 2 hour shift.
3. Return their unsold booklets and sign off on the verification form at the end of the event.

The funds from the booklets sold by our selling associates are divided equally at the end of the event to all qualifying organizations.

**NOTE: We keep 100% of what we sell and if we qualify we earn extra incentives. Last year we raised \$676.29.**
